

Prolegomenon to beyond the boundary of reality

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Our senses language and logic are the boundaries of our reality to go beyond this reality to reach a deeper understanding and access to a more encompassing reality a reality in which our bounded reality is only an aspect of we must go beyond the boundary of our senses and go beyond the boundaries of our logic These

**boundaries set the border
between our limited reality
and the deeper reality Our
instruments which we
investigate our reality are
only extensions of our
senses and we use our
bounded logic and language
to make sense of the data**

BUT

***Perfume is invisible to the
ear***

Sound is invisible to the eye

**Colour is invisible to the
taste**

**Sweet is invisible to the
touch**

**Logic has an inbuilt
ontology via the law of
identity which implies an
essence this ontology
structures our reality around
things ie we believe
reality is made up of things**

**with an essence Example the
notion of a self an identity is
only a fiction of our
grammar made up of
pronouns We tend to see
our reality as static through
the prison of our nouns If
instead of nouns we had
verbs then reality changes to
one of fluidity process**

Example

**∫ look at the “moon” and see
a static thing**

BUT

**∫f instead of “moon” we had
the verb “mooning” then
reality changes to a thing in
motion changing process**

**“John” from implying a
static thing changes to**

**“Johning” a thing of change
and process**

**We are like a person in the
midst of a mountain and as
such cannot see the face of
the mountain—its boundary**

**We are like a person in the
midst of water but cant see
its face— its boundary ie the
oceans**

**We are like a person in the
midst of space but cant see
its face— its boundary ie ??**

**We are a person in our
reality/universe but cant see
its face- its boundary ie ??**

**Because Our senses
language and logic set the
boundaries of our reality**

**To go beyond our reality we
must go beyond Our senses
language and logic**

**Example in the short stories
of Chekov and some of**

**Hemingway the
meaning/reality is not
conveyed by the words and
sentence the meaning is
beyond words ie**

Take the sentence

**"For sale hand knitted baby
bootees unused"**

**In this sentence the meaning
is not in the words**

**One non-verbal meaning
could be**

**A mother knitted baby
bootees for her coming baby
but the baby died**

**So long as you look at the
words/reality you don't get
the meaning/deeper reality**

**You are like the person who
just looks at the pointing
finger and thus does not see
what the finger is pointing at**

**In the examples I have
given if you just focus on**

**the words then you will not
get the deeper meaning You
must go beyond the meaning
of the words and the
boundary of logic and
language to get the deeper
understanding**

**“ We are like a person in
the midst of a mountain and
as such cannot see the face
of the mountain—its
boundary”**
